Dear Fellow Worshipers:

Our plans for the High Holy Day services are now complete. The service times are listed on the previous page. Use the request form to order your tickets. Please note the following:

1. Tickets will be issued only upon payment of at least the first-quarter dues, full school fees, three (4) years building assessment and all arrears. Tickets will not be mailed after September 1. After that date, it will be necessary to come into the office to pick up your tickets.
2. Supplementary tickets for out of town guests may be purchased by members only. The cost is \$60 per person, per holiday and must be paid in advance. The office staff is not authorized to make exceptions.
3. Associate members may purchase tickets at a cost of \$60 per person, per holiday.
4. The office will issue reciprocal ticket forms if you will be worshiping in another Reform congregation.
5. Tickets will be required for all services. Ushers have been instructed to check all tickets. Tickets are not transferable. Please cooperate by having your tickets ready as you enter the Synagogue.
6. Children's Services, held in the afternoons of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur, are for children grade 2 and under and their parents. Central Synagogue will provide professional child care for during Rosh Hashana morning and Yom Kippur morning and afternoon worship services with a reservation. The child care is available for children up to the second grade. In order to provide a secure and safe environment for all children, we need to know how many children will be coming. Therefore, reservations are required. Please call the temple office before September 1st to reserve a place for your child.
7. Yom Kippur Afternoon Services will begin promptly at 4:00 PM. Memorial Services will begin at 5:30 PM followed by Concluding Services and end approximately 7:00 PM.
8. Please bring your own copies of *Gates of Repentance* to supplement the Synagogue's supply.
9. Memorialization of the names of your loved ones is available through the Book of Remembrance. Please attend to it promptly in order to avoid disappointment in not having the names included.

We will break the fast as a community with *hamotzi* immediately following the concluding service.

May we all be blessed with the gift of life, good health and peace for the year ahead.
